

## Terms and Conditions for 2016 Season Tickets

1. Season Ticket Entry Fees: The entry fee for the respective Season Ticket is detailed upon the entry system and will be the fee applicable at the date of submission of the entry application form.

2. Entry Policy: Entrants must be at least 15 years of age on the day of the first race for the Historic Cities Season Ticket, Yorkshire Season Ticket, 10K Series Ticket, 17 years of age on the day of the first race for the White Rose Double Season Ticket and 18 years of age on the day of the marathon for the White Rose Rover Season Ticket and White Rose Ultimate Season Ticket. Under UK Athletic Rules and Regulations, participants under the age of 18 years must obtain parental consent in order to register and participate in the event.

3. Participants enter the event entirely at their own risk: We shall not be liable for any injury or loss occurring as a result of participation (including, without limitation, resulting from negligence), provided always that nothing in these terms and conditions shall exclude or limit our liability for death or personal injury resulting from the event organiser's negligence or for any other type of liability that cannot be excluded or limited by law.

4. Medical Conditions: It is recommended that you prepare and train for these events. Please consult your doctor for a check-up if you have not exercised for some time. If you have a medical condition it must be detailed on the reverse of your race number provided. Also, we strongly advise that you seek medical advice before participating in this event and that you disclose to those medical advisors the nature of this event.

5. Race Numbers: Race entries are not interchangeable. Entries cannot be assigned, transferred or sold to any third party and is therefore strictly prohibited.

6. Withdrawal from Event: If you are unable to take part in the first event and you do not wish to participate in the other events, we will issue a credit after the event as follows:

- Notification dated 12 weeks (56 days) or more before the first event of the respective Season Ticket = 50% credit
- Notification dated 6 weeks to 12 weeks (42 days to 55 days) before the first event of the respective Season Ticket = 20% credit
- Notification dated less than 6 weeks before the first event of the respective Season Ticket = nil

To receive a credit, you must notify Run For All in writing by email or by post. The date of withdrawal is the date of the email or as postmarked on the envelope.

Please state clearly your full name, registration id, date of birth and the event you are withdrawing from.

7. No Pets or Dogs: With the exception of registered assistance dogs. The organisers must be advised in advance if an entrant is to be accompanied by an assistance dog.

8. Aided participants: For those participants who are aided around the course, either being pushed or assisted, the guide must also be a registered participant in the event.

9. Wheelchair Entrants: It is strongly recommended that only experienced wheelchair racers attempt the race unaided.

10. For reasons of safety: No entries are permissible from participants on bikes, roller skates, in pushchairs or any kind of mechanical aid. No participants under the age of 15 will be allowed on the course at any time in the 10Ks and under the age of 18 in the marathon.

11. Data Protection: In compliance with the Data Protection Act 1998 you have the right of access to your personal records held on our computer. In order to send you a race pack and fundraising pack (if requested), and produce your race results, you are authorising us to release personal details (including your full name and address) to the pack provider, charity (if applicable) and timing results company.

12. Use of Image: By entering this event you give permission for the free use of your name, voice or picture in any broadcast, telecast, advertising, promotion or other medium in relation to any Run For All activity.

13. Baggage Storage: All personal items and items of clothing may be deposited prior to the race in the designated areas. However, the race organisers and officials do not accept any responsibility whatsoever for the safe keeping or the storage of those items which are stored and deposited entirely at the risk of the participant.

14. First Aid: Adequate First Aid assistance is provided for the duration of the event. There are clearly signed First Aid points both on the course, and at the start/finish area. Please note that Volunteers and Marshals in attendance at the race are not medically trained and will not give medical assistance other than requesting an ambulance or paramedic in the event that medical assistance is required.

15. Collections: Those wishing to make a charity collection on race day will need to obtain prior written authorisation from Run For All Ltd. Please note that we may not be able to grant permission for collections to every request.

16. Race Cancellation: If due to unforeseen circumstances any event in the season ticket is cancelled, our entire liability is as detailed below. We will not cover and further costs and expenses you may incur. The relevant entry fee, unless you indicate otherwise on the entry form, will be donated to the Jane Tomlinson Appeal. Entrants may be offered a substitute place in an alternative event of equivalent or greater value.

Yorkshire Season Ticket and Historic Cities Season Ticket

Cancellation of one event: refund of 25 per cent of the fee paid at the time of entry

10K Series Season Ticket

Cancellation of one event: refund of 12.5 per cent of the fee paid at the time of entry

White Rose Double

Cancellation of one event: refund of 40 per cent of the fee paid at the time of entry

White Rose Rover

Cancellation of a 10K event: refund of 15 per cent of the fee paid at the time of entry

Cancellation of a Marathon event: a refund of 40 per cent of the fee paid at the time of entry

White Rose Ultimate

Cancellation of a 10K event: refund of 12.5 per cent of the fee paid at time of entry

Cancellation of a Half Marathon event: 17.5 per cent of the fee paid at time of entry

Cancellation of a Marathon event: 30 per cent of the fee paid at the time of entry

17. Change of address: You should notify the organisers of any change of address or contact details.

If you have applied online, you will have been allocated a username and password, which allows you the ability to make this change yourself.

Please note that failure to inform Run For All / Marathon Yorkshire of a change of address 6 weeks before the event, may result in your pack being dispatched to the wrong address and a replacement pack will only be available for collection on race day at a cost of £5.

18. Race mementos: Only finishers will receive a race memento.

19. Mailing Lists: Your name will be added to our mailing list so that we can keep you informed about 'Run For All' events. This information may also be given to other carefully screened organisations involved with the Run For All and Marathon Yorkshire events. If you prefer your name not to be included you should indicate on your entry form.

20. Disclaimer: I accept all conditions of entry set out herein or notified to me prior to the race or displayed at the race or any instruction given to me by the organisers or officials of the race and, I acknowledge that the organisers and officials of the race shall (subject to clause 3 above) have no liability for any loss or damage I may suffer including consequential or indirect loss as a consequence of my participation in the Season Ticket Specials. Run For All and Marathon Yorkshire assumes no liability in respect of the state or condition of the surface upon which the event is held and all participants should ensure that they are satisfied with the state and condition of the surface of the route before commencing the event.

For entrants under 18 years of age please ensure your parent / legal guardian agrees the following:

As the parent or legal guardian of the child named within this application, I have read fully and accept the Terms and Conditions of entry and I hereby give my full consent and approval for my child to participate in the Scenic Season Ticket / Yorkshire Season Ticket / 10K Season Ticket / White Rose Double Season Ticket. I understand that there are certain risks of injury inherent in the practice and play of this sport. I am willing to assume these risks on behalf of my child. I hereby certify that my child is fully capable of participating in the event and that my child is healthy and has no medical conditions that would restrict full participation in these activities.
